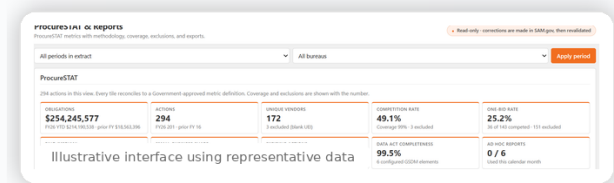

AwardIQ360 continuously ingests public FPDS/SAM award data, applies version-controlled validation logic, routes anomalies through accountable workflows, and delivers role-based dashboards and reports. The result is a more consistent operating model for procurement oversight—one that strengthens data quality, improves transparency, and preserves the evidence needed for reviews, audits, and management decision-making.

Core Features

Automated Ingestion & Lineage

Continuously loads new award records from FPDS/SAM APIs and retains source dates, identifiers, and ingestion details for end-to-end traceability.

Rule-Based Validation & Governance

Applies explainable validation rules with documented authorities, effective dates, versions, severity, and user-facing error descriptions.

Exception & Notification Workflow

Creates actionable exceptions for identified issues, routes them to responsible users and supervisors, and tracks status through correction and re-validation.

V&V Sampling & Review Support

Generates statistically valid quarterly or annual samples, supports independent element-level review, and records findings for completion and drill-down analysis.

ProcureSTAT Reporting & Traceability

Tracks procurement performance measures such as competition, PALT, socioeconomic spend, and DATA Act completeness while exposing calculation basis, eligible populations, and exclusions.

Role-Based Dashboards

Provides tailored views for executives, contracting professionals, reviewers, and analysts—from enterprise trends down to individual contract details.

Audit Trail & Versioning

Version-controls rules, methodologies, reports, and data changes so agencies can understand when, why, and how a validation or metric changed.

Deployment & Engagement

AwardIQ360 is offered as a managed SaaS solution or managed service with flexible subscription pricing. During the initial engagement, Canopy One configures the platform to the agency’s organization—including bureau and office hierarchy, users, reporting periods, workflows, and approved rule set.

A fast-track deployment targets approximately 30 days to working capability and includes data onboarding, rule loading, report configuration, access setup, workflow validation, and user training. This configuration-first model is designed to move agencies to operational use quickly while preserving controlled governance and traceability.

Agency hierarchy, users, rules, reporting methods, workflows, and dashboards are configured around an existing product capability—not built from scratch for every engagement.

Security & Compliance

AwardIQ360 is designed for federal data environments and can operate within an agency-approved cloud or on-premises boundary. The platform processes public FPDS/SAM award data plus limited agency-provided metadata such as user lists and organizational hierarchy, preserving existing information boundaries and avoiding unnecessary data exposure.

Canopy One provides system architecture documentation, control mappings, audit logs, and configuration evidence to support an agency’s security authorization and compliance review processes. Rules, methodologies, workflows, and reporting logic remain transparent and reviewable so agencies can understand how results are generated and changed over time.
